The company self-performs storm and debris cleanup, earthwork and site development, underground utilities, and vertical construction across the Southeastern United States, backed by more than twenty years of hands-on field experience. C & G Farms holds a 5.0 customer rating across more than 200 completed projects and a consistent record of finishing ahead of schedule and within budget.

CORE COMPETENCIES

- On-Site Sawmilling and Lumber Production. Conversion of harvested or salvaged logs into rough-sawn and dimensional lumber, including kiln drying, planing, and tongue-and-groove milling for use in on-site construction.
- Land Clearing and Disaster Debris Management. Tree and stump removal, storm and debris cleanup, and salvage of usable timber, suited to post-storm and emergency-recovery requirements.
- Site Preparation and Earthwork. Grading, excavation, fill placement, slope stabilization, retaining walls, and compaction testing to deliver permit-ready, foundation-ready sites.
